

<b>ABC Paragraph</b>	<b>A-B-C Paragraph breakdown when writing a quick-write or body paragraph:</b>
<b>A</b>	Answer the Question
<b>B</b>	Back it Up with an Evidence
<b>C</b>	Comment with an Explanation

**A-** Answer the question or provide a claim (1 sentence).

**B-** Back it up with evidence/an example (sentences vary).

-Never leave a quote dangling. Include Introductory expressions such as *For example "...", The speaker states "..."* etc.

-Include parenthetical citations when necessary: (Smith 32).

-Evidence: examples, statistics, facts, anecdotes, personal experiences, etc.

**C-** Comment on what the evidence shows to make your point (at least 3 sentences).

-Provide commentary on the the author/speaker means by this evidence.

-This should also include a rule (warrant) which is a general rule in society

\*Begin the rule/warrant with "most would agree" "Typically," "Usually," "Most would...," etc. (At least 3 sentences).
