- **A-** Answer the question or provide a claim (1 sentence).
- B-Back it up with evidence/an example (sentences vary).
 - -Never leave a quote dangling. Include Introductory expressions such as For example "...", The speaker states "..." etc.
 - -Include parenthetical citations when necessary: (Smith 32).
 - -Evidence: examples, statistics, facts, anecdotes, personal experiences, etc.
- **C-**Comment on what the evidence shows to make your point (at least 3 sentences).
 - -Provide commentary on the the author/speaker means by this evidence.
 - -This should also include a rule (warrant) which is a general rule in society

 *Begin the rule/warrant with "most would agree" "Typically," "Usually," "Most would...," etc. (At least 3 sentences).
